Click the "start" button to be taken to the activity, knowledge check, or chapter test. If you've previously started the assignment, the button will read "continue".

Completed Work tab will show you any assignments you have fully completed at least one time. You will also have access to a list of all your completed work via the Detailed Results section, which will show you each attempt on each assignment for the entire course.



If your instructor has allowed multiple attempts at the assignment, you will be able to access the assignment with the "Retake" button.

The assignment will show you the last time you completed the assignment, the current grade you have in your instructor's gradebook, and how many questions you got correct on the last attempt.

At the end of the assignment, you will:
